



STUDIO FACILITIES

- the Nancy Fairfax AIR studio is part of the Tweed Regional Gallery & Margaret Olley Art Centre, located at 2 Mistral Road Murwillumbah, and is accessible 24 hours a day
- the facility includes a deck, studio area, sleeping area with double bed, a kitchenette and an accessible bathroom
- the facility is wheelchair accessible
- the dimensions of the studio section is 5.3m by 4.9m
- the studio floors are ply wood

- easel
- work table

- stove top and convection microwave oven
- bar fridge
- television
- washer-dryer

- wireless internet

- bath towels (Gallery launders these at end of residency)

- basic domestic cleaning equipment

WHAT DO APPLICANTS NEED TO PROVIDE?


- own food

- drop-sheets for floors (if required)

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- artists using the studio will need to keep noise to a minimum during Gallery hours
- no alterations can be made to the walls
- pets are not allowed
- assistance animals permitted
- the studio is not suitable for young children
- the Gallery is located away from shops and other amenities, so independent access to local transport is essential (payment covered by Gallery)
- smoking is not permitted in the facility


floor plan
