

## Byron Writers Festival Residential Mentorship Terms & Conditions

- 1. The program is open to current Byron Writers Festival members only.
- 2. Applicants must be 18 years of age or over
- 3. Applicants must reside in the catchment area (from Tweed Heads to Taree and west to Kyogle)
- 4. Manuscripts should be fiction or narrative non-fiction.
- 5. In order to be eligible, applicants must be available for the entire period of the mentorship and be able to attend as an individual without family or friends, and free themselves of all other commitments and obligations, including work.
- 6. Past recipients of the program are eligible to apply in 2020.
- 7. Work should be submitted as a single Word Document or PDF, using 12 point, Times New Roman font, double-spaced and paginated.
- 8. Application and submission of work is via the online form only.
- 9. The Festival's decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
- 10. Four places are offered as part of Byron Writers Festival Residential Mentorship.
- 11. The four successful applicants will be required to contribute a fee of \$280 each towards the cost of their residency, to be paid to Byron Writers Festival upon agreement and acceptance of their place in the program.
- 12. Successful applicants will be required to cover their own travel costs to and from the residency location.
- 13. The program dates are yet to be confirmed due to developments with the Covid-19 outbreak.
- 14. The Festival reserves the right to reject any applications that do not follow entry guidelines.
