

Byron Writers Festival Members Mentoring Scholarships Terms & Conditions

- 1. The program is open to current Byron Writers Festival members only.
- 2. Recipients of the previous year's mentoring scholarships program are not eligible to apply.
- 3. Submissions in all genres welcome excluding picture books, graphic novels and poetry.
- 4. Work should be submitted as a Word Document.
- 5. Applicants should submit up to five pages of their work for consideration (double-spaced, Times New Roman, 12-point font), together with a one-page synopsis which includes the genre of their work and a short author biography (please submit one document only).
- 6. Application and submission of work is via the online form only.
- 7. The Festival's decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
- 8. Four Firsthand Feedback sessions are on offer, with one session reserved for an Indigenous writer.
- 9. All mentors are subject to availability.
- 10. Mentorships may take place in late in the current year or early in the following.
- 11. We reserve the right to reject any applications that do not follow entry guidelines
