

Byron Writers Festival Members Mentoring Scholarships Terms & Conditions

1. The program is open to current Byron Writers Festival members only.
2. Recipients of the previous year's mentoring scholarships program are not eligible to apply.
3. Submissions in all genres welcome excluding picture books, graphic novels and poetry.
4. Work should be submitted as a Word Document.
5. Applicants should submit up to five pages of their work for consideration (double-spaced, Times New Roman, 12-point font), together with a one-page synopsis which includes the genre of their work and a short author biography (please submit one document only).
6. Application and submission of work is via the online form only.
7. The Festival's decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
8. Four Firsthand Feedback sessions are on offer, with one session reserved for an Indigenous writer.
9. All mentors are subject to availability.
10. Mentorships may take place in late in the current year or early in the following.
11. We reserve the right to reject any applications that do not follow entry guidelines
