Workshop

1hr Author Presentation to the whole school

2hr Creative writing workshop with max. 30 students

(The workshop is extremely flexible. We recommend the workshop class to be between years 3 - 6 for Primary and years 7 - 10 for Secondary)

Time

StoryBoard workshops are scheduled to fit within your schools timetable.

Approx. 10am - 1.30pm.

With a scheduled lunch break usually between 11 - 11.30am.

We do ask the schools to provide a small morning tea for the author and volunteer tutor.
